

Basic Moves which may be used during breaks in the compulsory dance:

1. Allemande left – Allemande right
2. Balance – to corner – to partner
3. Do Si Do – corner – partner
4. Grand Chain (right and left)
5. Reverse Grand Chain
6. Grand Square (sides face, heads face, ladies face)
7. Ladies chain – $\frac{1}{2}$ or $\frac{3}{4}$ - 2 ladies or 4 ladies
8. Right Left through – back
9. Promenade – full or $\frac{1}{2}$
10. Swing – partner, corner or opposite
11. Ladies roll away with a $\frac{1}{2}$ chasse – from static square or circle
12. Honour – your partner or your corner
13. Wave to the girl across the hall
14. Circle – left or right
15. Centres fall

NOTE: at the callers discretion, various combinations of the above may be used

Acceptable Old Tyme Moves

1. Swing
2. Balance
3. Circle left or right
4. Do Si Do
5. Allemande left or right
6. Forward and back
7. Star by the right or left
8. Grand chain
9. Reverse grand chain
10. Left to the corner, chain
11. Promenade
12. $\frac{1}{2}$ Promenade
13. Star promenade
14. Pass through
15. Double pass through
16. Right and left through (and back)
17. Separate
18. Two or four ladies chain ($\frac{1}{2}$ or $\frac{3}{4}$)
19. Weave the ring
20. Roll away
21. Courtesy turn
22. Box the gnat
23. Chasse
24. Half chasse
25. Divide the couple
26. Hold your holts
27. Grand square (and reverse)
28. Back track
